

S + V + so as (not) to – infinitive

S + V + so that + S + can (not) / could(not) + V
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Ex : We study hard **so as to** get good marks. We study hard **in order to** get good marks./We study hard **so that** we can get good marks.

8. “ENOUGH” (adv): đủ để

a) The house is big enough for us to live in.

b) She is beautiful enough to become Miss World.

S + be + adj + enough + (for + O) + to- inf.
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9. “TOO” (adv): quá (too...to-inf: Quá...không thể)

a) He is too young to ride a motorbike.

b) The weather was too cold for us to go out.

S + be + TOO + adj + (for + O) + to-infinitive
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10. The structure: “ It’s + Adj + To infinitive ...” (thật là...)

To V ... + is + adj
V-ing... + is + adj
-> It is + adj + to V ...

Examples: a- To lie on the beach all day is wonderful.

->It is wonderful to lie on the beach.

b- Speaking English fluently is difficult.

->It’s difficult to speak English fluently.

c- It’s easy to find the notice board in the hall.

->To find the notice board in the hall is easy.

“gerund” or “to infinitive”:

Ex: Do you like reading novels ?

preposition (in, at, on,of,...) + V-ING

Ex: English people are fond of watching football.

causative form: Have + S.O + V (active)

Have + S.T + Ved/ 3 (passive)

Make + O + V

Ex:- I have my brother repair my bicycle.

- They had their suitcases taken upstairs to their rooms.

- The clown made us laugh a lot.
